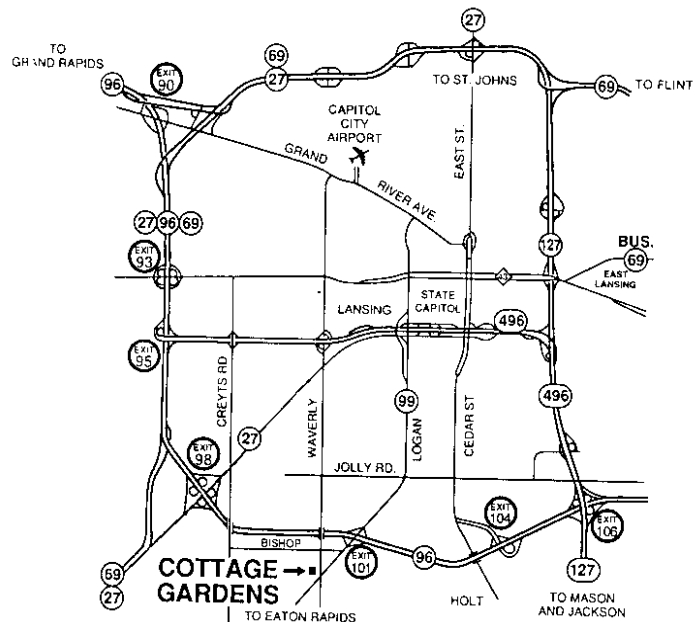
- Specific product descriptions and required quantities.
